All students pursuing the Ph.D. through the School of Education are required to complete at least one semester of college teaching experience during the course of their doctoral studies. Enrollment for this experience under the designated course in the student's department (e.g., C&T 996) is not required by the School of Education—although the student's department or program may require such enrollment.

To meet the college teaching experience, a student must engage in a semester-long, planned instructional activity that includes college classroom teaching under supervision. Planning of the experience is to be done with the advisor and/or mentor of the faculty who will supervise the experience. The activity is to be done under the supervision of a member of the University of Kansas faculty or by an individual or individuals designated by the student's doctoral committee.

Completion of the college teaching experience may be completed during the semester in which the student takes the comprehensive examination, but ordinarily is to be completed before admission to the comprehensive examination.
